




You may hear that familiar refrain that starts "take me out to the" when you visit this site. Enter the prairie trail near the parking lot and keep your eyes peeled for this station.




If driving, park on the road and walk into the park. Go past the playground construction and cross the creek into the prairie section of this park. Find your clue sheet there.


From the parking lot, venture over to the edible forest garden managed by Backyard Abundance. You'll spot your pollinator enjoying the variety of edible and native plants found there.
