Utility Discount Program for Income Eligible Customers

Eligible Iowa City utility customers can receive a discount of 75% off the minimum water and sewer charges, 75% off monthly storm water charge, and 75% off refuse, recycling, and organics charges each month.

Eligible customers meet the following criteria:

- Participation in one of the following: SSI (Supplemental Security Income), or SSDI (Social Security Disability Insurance); FIP (Family Investment Program); Title XX (Childcare Assistance); SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program); receiving Elderly Tax Credit on your real estate tax or State Rent Reimbursement.
- All household residents must be eligible for one or more of the programs to be eligible for the utility discount.

To apply: You must sign an “Authorization for Release of Information” form available from the Revenue Division of the City of Iowa City at 410 E. Washington Street or online at icgov.org/utilities. Your eligibility will be verified by Johnson County Health & Human Services, and/or the Social Security Administration or the Johnson County Treasurer. If eligible, the discount will go into effect following verification.

***Note:** The discount will be in effect through June of the year in which you applied. To renew, you must reapply between April 1 and June 15. The discount remains in effect one year for SSI/SSDI, FIP, Title XX, and SNAP, and two years for Elderly Tax Credit or Rent reimbursement.
